**Schedule/Compensation**

Musicians are scheduled and paid according to the instrumentation needed for each show as dictated in the collective bargaining agreement. The season is normally 7 shows each summer from June through mid-August. Weekly base wages for 2024 are \$1,754.08/per week. The Muny Orchestra is covered by a collective bargaining agreement with the Musicians' Association of St. Louis, Local 2-197.

The Muny Orchestra is considered a local orchestra and, as such, travel and housing for travel and housing for out-of-town musicians is the responsibility of the musician.
